Thank you for considering us for your summer schedule! Students will be led by experienced and well-trained teachers from the Boulder area who are highly involved in the music teachers' community. Our camp contains two tracks so every child can have a music-filled summer! Students will learn short group and duet performances to share with family and friends on **Friday of each session at 2 PM**. The video performance will be recorded for family members to enjoy. Students will also complete crafts throughout the week that they will be able to keep after camp ends.

Adventurers is designed for students in rising K-3rd grades and/or don't have any piano experience. We will learn the basics of music-making, how to write our own stories through music, and much more!

Explorers is designed for students in rising 4th-6th grades and/or have taken private piano lessons before. We will dive deeper into piano-specific activities, giving students a chance to perform with each other, play duets, and learn general music theory.
